The Auburn Enlarged City School District's budget shortfall is strictly due to a lack of Foundation Aid from New York State – it has nothing to do with the turf project. The coincidental timing of the turf project and the budget issues are unfortunate, as they can easily create confusion, but they are unrelated. **Even if we were to cancel the turf project tomorrow, it would have absolutely no impact on the current budget pressure the district is facing.**
